

Christian American or American Christian

If you are Christian and American, like 85% of the U.S., then which allegiance is first? What, you don't want to choose between Christian and American? Eventually, the Puritan Liberals will make you choose. Your day of reckoning cometh.

Recently, Gov. Jeb Bush and LTG Jerry Boykin made their choice. They may not have seen their individual controversy as subordinating either their faith or their citizenship, but it happened.

Gov. Bush acted courageously against judicial tyranny. A judge, a robed priest-king, ordered a woman to die by starvation. A Christian American would wash his hands and cluck at the courts. A Christian American would genuflect to the 'rule of law' even if it's really just the 'rule of judges'. Gov. Bush fought the illegal ruling with a law from the Florida legislature and executive – the branches who are supposed to write, approve and execute the laws. His American Christian conscience did not let him bow and scrape to the judge. Now, if another priest-king judge rules this specific law unconstitutional, will the Governor use the executive authority to grant clemency? He has the police and public health power to order protection for life. American Christians have the moral, legal – Florida and U.S. Constitutional - duty to preserve God-given inalienable rights.

Judges are not the law of the land. The United States of America is based on the Declaration of Independence and its four references to the Judeo-Christian God. Our present, second Constitution is a superstructure framework of government and list of permanent *individual* rights. If another higher black robe demands this Florida citizen die by his writ, it will take moral clarity and uncommon political courage for Gov. Bush to defy an illegal, immoral, unconstitutional order. American Christians must obey the Constitution and the Ten Commandments over any person in authority. God grant Bush the vision and steel his heart.

Courage is the career of Special Ops LTG Boykin. He spoke *verboten* Christian speech in a public in Army uniform. The Anti-Christian Liberals and their Muslim allies want his head on a spike. LTG Boykin made his apologies as a Christian American man under secular authority. Yet, his original comments and part of his explanation were righteous American Christian speech. Today, anyone who believes in the Holy Bible and worships the one, true God therein – be you Protestant, Roman Catholic, Orthodox or Jew – is not allowed to say so. LTG Boykin got the message to shut up. Yet, Muslims can say the Koran and Allah are the one and only way. Muslims are a protected minority. Christians are a persecuted majority – as long as they take it.

Cultural cleansing of Christian speech, symbols, and history sweeps schools, colleges and universities, the work place, in the public square, and throughout the media. It's getting worse. So much has been lost since the Culture War started in 1962. Priest-king judges are ruling over the law, not under the law. Look at the Florida, Nevada, New Jersey, California, and Alabama justices, 9th Circuit Appeals Court, and five members of the U.S. Supreme Court since 2000...as only the highlights of abuse. Listen to the Liberals-Democrats-Media-Sissy Christians-Pagan Secularists-Muslims spit venom against a Christian exercising his First Amendment in church and a Governor saving a woman's life.

What irony for President George W. Bush to make his P.C. criticism of LTG Boykin in Indonesia. President Bush should tell the thousands of murdered, raped, forcibly converted, and refugee Indonesian Christians in Timor, Celebes and across the archipelago how Islam is a religion of peace.

Perhaps We, the People, should remind the President that Revolutionary Christians created an independent America and the ideas for Americans. It was comfortable to rend separately to American Caesar and the Lord for most of our history. The historical exceptions prove the rule and set the standard.

Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. violated the unconstitutional and immoral rule of segregation law – imposed by the legislature, enforced by the executive, upheld for decades by the judiciary – including the U.S. Supreme Court (1892) - as the law of the land. Dr. King was arrested and imprisoned under the law. Yet, he is the only American with his own national holiday. As an American Christian he followed the higher law until the rule of lesser laws was righted. The time is coming to do it again.

The point for Americans is on the sword of truth. American Christians follow the higher laws of their God - One they know from a personal relationship - not the orders of a foreign authority. Not so for American citizens, Muslims, arrested and convicted of committing jihad against their own country.

American Christians and Jews created this country, built it, defended it, expanded

freedoms and opportunity, opened it to others than Christians and Jews, and will either save it or lose it – sooner than you could ever imagine.

Soon enough at school, work, community or public event, you will have to choose. Will you speak or be silent? Our Patriot Founders told the Brits and Tories, “We have no king, but Jesus.” What say you? Are you a Christian American or an American Christian?
