

Martin Luther, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and Chief Justice Roy Moore

I saw the movie 'Luther' before it left theaters. Good movie. Great history. The only thing at odds with what I read in several biographies about Martin Luther was Luther's astounding courage of convictions. The movie didn't show that Martin Luther expected to be burned at the stake within a week of declaring his conscience. Luther was surprised when he stayed alive. Luther was prepared for a horrible death because he loved freedom more than he feared death. Luther's legacy lives.

Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. had an equal expectation of death, but was unsure of the hour. His murder came before his 40th birthday. Yet, like Martin Luther the Reformer, Dr. King could do no other than what his conscience commanded. He put freedom for himself and millions of others ahead of his life. MLK Jr. broke the law and defied the legislature, the executive and the judiciary for individual rights.

The Chief Justice of Alabama Roy Moore was stripped from his job by Republican justices at the behest of the Republican attorney general. Roy Moore, now just citizen Moore, has the same courage born of the same faith for the same ends – truth that leads to freedom, no matter what. Roy Moore, the good West Pointer, was faithful to his oath of office – as any military officer and public official is true to the commission to obey all '*lawful*' orders.

Roy Moore stood for a narrow point of law. The simple facts are missing in the criticisms. Yet, his real stroke is for individual freedom of conscience – as our law demands truly and our judges deny. Every public officer, anywhere, must civilly disobey unlawful orders. Remember the Nuremburg and My Lai trials.

Martin Luther King, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and Roy Moore disobeyed unlawful - illegal – immoral edicts, laws, and rulings against their individual conscience. They were willing to pay the consequences, regardless, to live as free men. This is the power of freedom. Authorities can fine, punish, imprison and kill – but they never control the thoughts and speech of men determined to live or die free. Just as the Apostle Paul was a free man when he was chained to guards and when he put his head on the executioner's block, so is the freedom of Martin Luther, Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. and Roy Moore. You are free if you will it as they did.

Most Republicans and many Conservatives are squeamish about defying authority. Law and order is in their DNA. Yet, the Declaration of Independence points to the moral imperative to resist illegal authority and begs the question "When?"

Good Conservative Republicans say no one can disobey a Federal Judge ruling. Wrong. They are missing the one little word that means everything – Lawful. Everyone should obey lawful rulings. Everyone should disobey UNLAWFUL – ILLEGAL – IMMORAL Federal judge orders.

What if everyone did that – followed their individual conscience to determine which judgments are lawful? That is precisely what everyone should do. Everyone should evaluate every order from government. If a person determines the government is wrong and resists – and stands all alone – then the person was a nut or a martyr. If a person is joined by many others – it's called a Reformation or a Civil Rights Movement.

The Puritan Liberals are eager for witch trials, inquisitions, and banishment against the heretics of individual conscience. The judicial oligarchy and their fawning Liberal subjects will not tolerate disobedience to a judge's order. How dare anyone defy the Bench? Liberals Elites know the black-robed Priest-Kings are their final power to tell you peasants what to do, say and think. They want you to worship Political Correctness.

Political Correctness is a dogma as rigid as the Puritan's creed, as ruthless as a growing totalitarianism, and as rigorously zealous as religious piety for pagans, secularists and sissy Christians. The acolytes of PC say they all about tolerance, but, really they just hate. Actually, labels like PC, Liberal, Oligarchy and Tyranny fail to capture the magnitude of what their hate will do to America.

One of the telling scenes in Luther is at the book burning of Luther's writings. The henchman holding the torch hands it over to the official saying in effect, "No, you do it. I'm not going to burn Luther's works." America is at that day. Blind justice doesn't demand blind obedience, even if justice were indeed blindly fair. Most of the Bench rules with a left eye open. Judges making up laws, perverting laws, overruling laws create injustice. Brave Americans like the Cherokee County, GA supervisors, town leaders in Tennessee, etc. are standing up against the unlawful rulings. Will the Massachusetts legislature fight back?

Like, when a robed Priest-King says the mute, truthful testimony to our history – the Ten Commandments – on display in a public place is the establishment of religion – that judge is wrong. The stupidity of that ruling would be funny if it weren't so frightening as part of the cultural cleansing of American Christianity. The words that are a huge part of the foundation of the American Nation simply offer silent acknowledgement of facts. The Ten Commandments display doesn't require you to go to church, give to a church, believe anything, say anything, sacrifice your young, think anything or worship in any way before them. So, how does it 'establish a church'? It doesn't, duh – even if a judge says so.

Even if the Supreme Court unanimously says the Ten Commandments establish a church, their ruling will be the 'law' for awhile, but it will be wrong - and unlawful. They were wrong at different times on slavery, segregation, internment, public prayer, abortion, affirmative action, etc. They are merely a one political branch of a government

of men – not saints, not kings, not priests. Let people with eyes see and ears hear for themselves.

Expect to pay a price if you resist authority based on your individual conscience. Roy Moore should reckon to be fired as he was.

Expect the rewards of freedom if you are right. The people of Alabama can fire the other justices and the attorney general. They can re-hire Roy Moore as Chief Justice – unless the Alabama lawyers disbar him in their fright.

Will you let a handful of judges, the black-robed priest-king oligarchy, exercise judicial tyranny to destroy the Judeo-Christian value of marriage between man and woman? The PC judges will create homosexual marriage, group marriage, polygamy, and incestuous marriage. There is no moral, ethical barrier to stop the judges, just the political will of the People through their legislators.
